

UNIONID MOLLUSKS LISTED BY THE STATE OF OHIO
AS ENDANGERED WILD ANIMALS
WITH NOMENCLATURE UPDATED TO APRIL 1985

Since the listing of the following unionids (Ohio Dept. Nat. Res., 1976) as Endangered Wild Animals a number of nomenclatorial corrections have been made. The American Malacological Union has, in addition, generated a list of common names which has been presented to their membership for evaluation and adoption. Although it appears that all of the nomenclatorial errors in this list have been corrected, it seems unlikely that the proposed list of common names will be adopted entirely as presented. Moreover, increases in our knowledge of the relationships of these forms may well necessitate some unanticipated nomenclatorial changes in the future. Even so this updated list, reflecting as it does our present knowledge of these taxa, is much more useful than that compiled in 1983.
